- The research papers should have abstract, keywords, introduction, conclusion, suggestions and findings and references, authors name, designation, department name, college/university name, place and state within 2000 words.
- Research paper should be typed in MS Word 2007.
- Title of Research Paper should be typed in 14 Size font and Bold with Underline.
- Authors / Research Scholar Names with College Address should be typed in 12 Size Font and Bold.
- Reference should be in Vancouver style at End of the paper (Endnote).
- Page Size: A4 size only.
- Text Column: Single Texts, Align: Justify.
- Title: 24pt Times New Roman, Align: Centre.
- Page Margins: Left -0.51", Right- 0.51", Top- 0.75", Bottom- 0.75".
- Font: Arial (English), Font Size:10 and Kruti Dev-10 (Hindi), Font Size-14 for Whole Paper.
- Figure Caption: Font Size- 10" Lower Case and Write below the figure, Position- Centre.
- Paragraph: Paragraph Indentation by- 0.2".
- Line Spacing: Single.
- Before: 0", After: 0".
- Header- 0.3", Footer: 0".
- Figures must be inserted into the document in JPEG.
- Cover Page should contain "Title of the Paper", Author's and Co-author's name, designation with affiliated institution name, along with e-mail and contact number.
- An early submission of the full paper for publication will be highly appreciated.
